NEAT DRESS (no jeans) and GOOD GOLF ETIQUETTE are expected at all times.

LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (defined by White Stakes)

The following are out of bounds:

- Over any boundary fence or hedge, in or over any drain, river or cutting defining the boundary of the course.
- Ball coming to rest beyond the white stakes to the left of the 12th fairway.
- The clubhouse enclosure car park and green-keepers sheds.

2. RELIEF

In the following cases a ball may be lifted and dropped, within one club length of the nearest point of relief, not nearer the hole, without penalty:

- If it is in a tyre rut.
- If it is in ground damaged by construction or drainage works.
- If it is in an area affected by bog oak.
- If a player's stance or intended swing is affected by staked or wired tree.
- If it lies on a pathway or so close that a player's stance or intended swing is affected.
- If it lies within two club lengths of a water hydrant or pop-up sprinkler which interferes with stance or line of play.

- If a ball lies on a tee other than the hole being played it must be dropped off, no nearer the hole.
- Relief off the pathway crossing the course i.e. on holes 10, 12, 13, 16, 17 and 18 may be dropped, no nearer the hole.

3. HAZARDS

All internal drains, ditches and lakes are either water hazards, defined by yellow markings, or lateral water hazards, defined by red markings. See Rule 33.

DROP ZONES: where these are provided they must be used.

4. BUNKERS

Stones in bunkers may be removed without penalty. See Rule 24.

5. E.S.B. POLES & WIRES

A ball striking overhead wires or supporting poles MUST be replayed without penalty.

6. MEMBERS & VISITORS

Members and Visitors may not trespass on any land adjoining the course. Such trespass means automatic disqualification from the competition. Use of motorised buggies is allowed subject to weather conditions.

G.U.R. (Ground under repair): Ball MUST be dropped (no nearer the hole) outside marked area - no penalty.
